Rip Off of Routine Mindset:

Matthew 16:23 “you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men”

- What is routine in the kingdom?

Mark 7: 1 - 15 “The Pharisees and some of the teachers of the law who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus and saw some of his disciples eating food with hands that were "unclean," that is, unwashed. (The Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they give their hands a ceremonial washing, holding to the tradition of the elders. When they come from the marketplace they do not eat unless they wash. And they observe many other traditions, such as the washing of cups, pitchers and kettles.) So the Pharisees and teachers of the law asked Jesus, "Why don't your disciples live according to the tradition of the elders instead of eating their food with 'unclean' hands?" He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: " 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men.' You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men." And he said to them: "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions! For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death.' But you say that if a man says to his father or mother: 'Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is Corban' (that is, a gift devoted to God), then you no longer let him do anything for his father or mother. Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that." Again Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this. Nothing outside a man can make him 'unclean' by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him 'unclean.' "

- The only thing that ever made the word of God powerless in scripture was traditions (routine)

Traditions: Encarta Dictionary

1. a long-established action or pattern of behavior in a community or group of people, often one that has been handed down from generation to generation

4. christianity the body of Christian doctrines that are accepted as the teachings of Jesus Christ and the apostles without written evidence

6. law especially in Roman and Scots law, the formal transfer of ownership of movable property

A schedule is not a routine, it is exercising foresight, vision, stewardship, and purposefulness Utilizing routines where they are helpful is useful (administrative)

- but mindsets belong to sustainable truths alone (don't lust, be generous etc) and not to acts of faith
- faith is evidence of the unseen and tradition is action based on seen

- If my mindset is routine WHILE preparing for my day I will never seek to improve effectiveness or employ others gifts and talents).
- In your journey as a leader you'll find that routine robs you of: expectancy, dreaming, growth and creative initiative,
- Picture routine as a tool to be applied.
- Now picture it as the mindset your trying to fit any of your ministry into (finances, worship, discipleship). They are contradictory.

Here is the quality of the kingdom of our God:

Isaiah 43: 9 “See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.”

Revelation 21:5 “And He Who is seated on the throne said, See! I make all things new.”

His mercies are new every morning!!

Mindsets of Living in Creative Flow: THE GRID

Ask each day, what will best...

- 1...express Fathers heart and invite His presence and dominion?
- 2...honor my God, my leadership, my peers, my students?
- 3...employ others gifts and empower their destinies?
- 4...improve quality, effectiveness, attainability, involvement?

Engage:

Write out responsibilities: how will I steward my heart and mind to live in creative flow that empowers others and improves quality? Write specifics to apply and we will go over these specifics and how they looked when applied (discipleship, setup, etc)

- creative flow hour per week (installing security lights - I had to tear each gasket!)
